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Notice of Public Hearing

Notice is Hereby given that the Tehama County Air Pollution Control District Board of Directors will hold a public hearing on Tuesday June 9, 2020 at 11:00 am or as soon thereafter as may be heard in the board chambers 727 oak Street, Red Bluff, California, to consider amendments to Rule 2:3c New Source Review, New and Major Stationary Sources in the Tuscan Buttes Nonattainment Area.

The purpose of the if the proposed rule is to meet requirements set by the US EPA for Districts with nonattainment areas in their jurisdiction. September 2016 California recommended that a new partial-county area be designated as “nonattainment” for the 2015 1-hour ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) based on data collected from federal Equivalent Method (FEM) monitors. The proposed rule will pertain specifically to the rea defined as those portions of the immediate Tuscan buttes area, located within township 28N Range 2W Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, at or above 1800 feet elevation, as referenced in 40 CFR 81.305.
