

## Notice of Public Hearing

Notice is Hereby given that the Tehama County Air Pollution Control District Board of Directors will hold a public hearing on Tuesday March 1, 2022 at 11:00 am or as soon thereafter as may be heard in the board chambers 727 Oak Street, Red Bluff, California, to consider amendments to Rule 4:34 Internal Combustion Engines.

The purpose of the proposed rule is to meet requirements set by AB 617. AB 617 requires that districts implement Best Available Retrofit Control Technology (BARCT) by the earliest feasible date. The proposed rule will pertain specifically to natural gas fuel engines that operate within Tehama County. Except from administrative requirements, agricultural and emergency engines continue to remain exempt.
